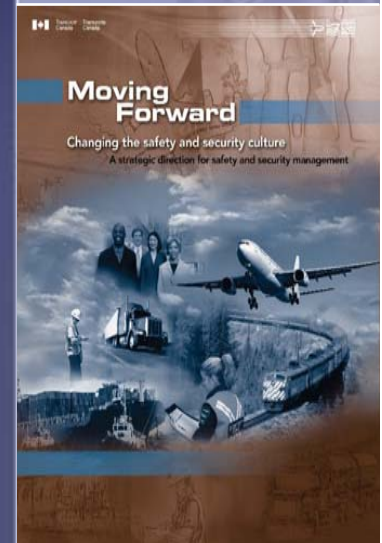
VISION

Safety and Security Management Policy

- Safety/Security Management Systems is Transport Canada Policy.
- Safety and security management requires a change in the way we all do business - from safety and security at the operations level to a systems-wide approach.
- The shift to managing safety and security represents a major cultural shift for many organizations.



“A formalized framework for integrating safety/security into the daily operations of a transportation enterprise.”

Civil Aviation's Top Priorities

Safety Management System – SMS

- Engage industry in the aviation safety management framework.

Integrated Management System – IMS

- Integrate risk management and performance measurement in support of continuous performance improvement.

To develop and administer policies and regulations for the safest civil aviation system for Canada and Canadians, using a systems approach to managing risks.
